Petite Art in the Park

Call for Artists 2009

The Seacoast Science Center invites you to participate in *Petite Art in the Park*, a special event that is part of a week-long celebration called *Art in Nature* to be held **July 6-12, 2009**. Join the seacoast art community in supporting the Center's efforts to create new and creative ways of connecting our visitors to the environment and expanding the ways we see the world around us.

Painting on location in 135-acre Odiorne Point State Park offers unparalleled natural beauty. Vistas include the rugged rocky shore, the windswept salt marsh, the sandy beach and expansive woodlands. Historic sites include WWII fortifications and cultural gardens. The view from Odiorne Point includes the Wentworth by the Sea Hotel, the Isles of Shoals and four seacoast lighthouses.

We ask that artists work "en plein air" to create works on paper, canvas or board (**10" x10" or smaller**) during the week. Artists' must **submit 1-2 final pieces by Saturday afternoon (7/11)** to be exhibited and available for sale on Sunday, July 12. Each piece will be priced at a flat rate of \$75, unframed and hung on clothes-line. Artists will receive 80% of the sale price; 20% will benefit the Center. Space is limited to 75 participants.

Your resumé, brief artist's statement, 1-2 art reproductions for binder display due at time of registration (no slides please, digital print-out with name, title, etc. acceptable)
