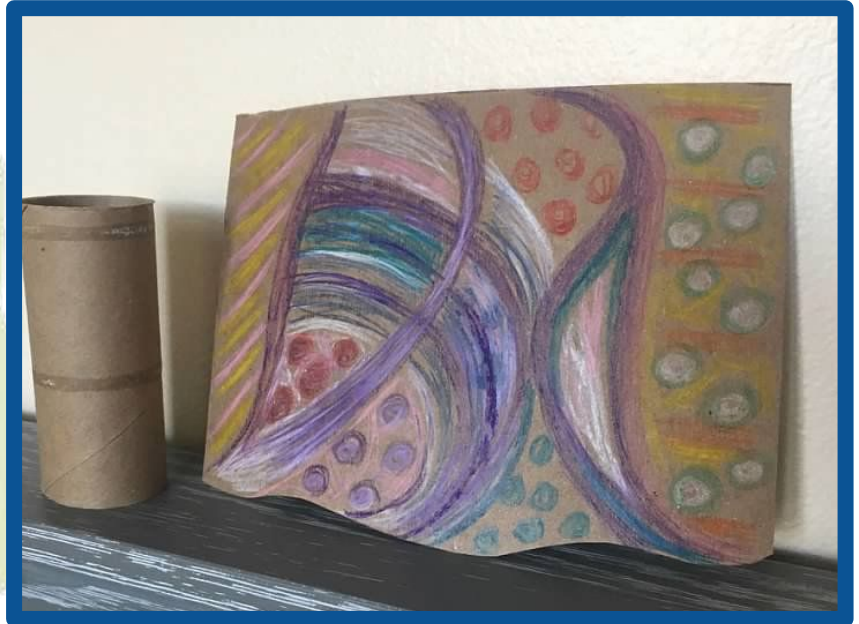


# Recycled Craft Time

**First**, gather your materials. I raided my recycling and my craft closet for **thin cardboard and crayons**.

## Additional Supplies

- Scissors
- Something to color or paint with. Markers and pastels are great!
- Tape
- Yarn
- Plastic



**Next**, cut your cardboard to the size you want. Color! Experiment with colors and textures, and remember you will be cutting it so it doesn't need to be perfect.

**Now**, roll your cardboard into a tube, like a toilet paper roll.

Tape the inside and the outside.

\*If tape isn't strong enough, try staples.



# Jellyfish Assembly

## Cut the tentacles.

I cut a wavy pattern about halfway up and bent some out.

\*Get a grownups help if you need it.

**Get creative!** I added yarn and a plastic wrapper, which I tied on with more yarn.
