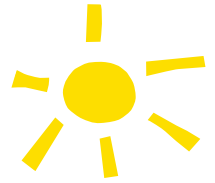

Monday, 2/18 & 2/25

Seahorse, of Course!

What is that cool looking fish? It's a seahorse, of course! Come learn about the amazing seahorse and other unique fish that inhabit the ocean. Watch our fish, including our seahorses, being fed their midday meal and learn about interesting adaptations fish have for survival in the sea.

Crustacean Curiosities

Crabs, lobsters, shrimp and barnacles belong to the hard-shelled, many-legged class known as crustaceans. We'll get hands on with these cool creatures, take a close look at crustacean anatomy and see shell molting in action, projected on a large screen in our learning studio.

Wednesday, 2/20 & 2/27

Winter Wildlife Walk

Explore the winter woods with us as we look for signs of wildlife, including tracks, scat, owl pellets, deer rubbings, and more. We'll learn which trees animals use for their winter survival and build observation forts to shield us as we view the winter landscape.

Thursday, 2/21 & 2/28

Stingers of the Sea

Many ocean creatures use venom as a weapon for survival. Come learn about sea jellies, anemones, sting rays, octopi, urchins, lionfish and more during this day of discovery. We'll play a fun game of "Zap!" and make a cool creature craft.

Friday, 2/22 & 3/1

Ahoy Mateys!

This is a day for all you scurvy landlubbers out there who love pirates! Come listen to tales of famous pirates that sailed the seven seas. Pull up your boot straps and join us for a treasure hunt in the park. Come dressed as a pirate, if ye are inclined.
